70's into the high 80's. We had sunny to partly cloudy skies. The lake level was up about 4' and falling. Water temperatures were in the low to mid 80's and the water was heavily stained. Brian weighed in a nice 2.33 pound bass on Saturday which was one of only four fish weighed in for the day. Brian's fish won Big Bass for Saturday. This is Brian's third Big Bass win so far this year and back

to back first place wins (Brian and his dad Mike took first place at the Mark Twain tournament last month). On Sunday Ken and Brian weighed in one fish each. The team weighed in three fish for a total of 7.02 pounds. They caught their fish on top water poppers, crankbaits and four inch worms. The first place payout was \$120. 

POMME DE TERRE TOURNAMENT

Our next tournament is August 7 & 8 at Lake Pomme de Terre. Take off is out of Pomme State Park Marina. Tournament hours for both Saturday and Sunday are 6:00am to 12:00pm.



In '09 Pomme was won by Mike Parmentier & Larry Rutledge with 7 fish @ 9.53 lbs. caught on green pumpkin Brush Hogs & Wave Worms. Other baits that worked were chartreuse crankbaits & spinnerbaits, green pumpkin worms, jigs & buzzbaits. Temps ranged from mid 80's to low 90's with water at around 83 degrees. The lake level was at normal pool with clear to stained water. It was sunny to partly cloudy & winds @ 10 - 20 MPH.
